FISCAL NOTE

HB 2186 – SB 2294

February 5, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Decreases, from 30 days to 10 business days, the amount of time the Executive Director of the Board of Nursing has to certify to the Governor the names of the officers after the election of the officers of the Board.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Executive Director of the Board can certify the names to the Governor in the new timeframe utilizing existing resources; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board of Nursing had an annual surplus of \$1,674,535 in FY17-18, an annual surplus of \$1,362,072 in FY18-19, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$10,934,363 on June 30, 2019.
