**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2194**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Decreases the period of time, from 90 days to 75 days following receipt of a complete application, by which the Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) must issue or deny an aquatic resource alteration permit (ARAP). Decreases the period of additional time which may be granted to TDEC if a public hearing is scheduled upon request from interested parties.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Reducing the period of time by which TDEC must approve or deny a permit will have no significant impact on state government.
- Reducing the period of additional time that must be provided to the Department upon scheduling of a hearing will have no significant impact upon state government.
