HB 2208 - SB 2139

SUMMARY OF BILL: Removes requirement that an aerial applicator of pesticides notify the Department of Agriculture (TDA) of any such application. Removes the TDA's responsibility to maintain an online reporting system to handle reports and notifications from aerial applicators of pesticides.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Expenditures - \$14,400/FY20-21 and Subsequent Years

Assumption:

- Based on information provided by the TDA, no longer having to maintain a database for online notification by aerial applicators will result in a recurring decrease in state expenditures of \$14,350, beginning in FY20-21.
