FISCAL NOTE

HB 2239 - SB 2170

February 24, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds a state or county medical examiner to the definition of healthcare practitioners for the *Tennessee Prescription Safety Act of 2016*.

Authorizes the release of deidentified data for any data that is authorized to be released pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 53-10-306.

Allows additional personnel with the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse (DMHSAS) to have access to the Controlled Substance Monitoring Database (CSMD).

Removes the restriction that data sharing outside of the state must be limited to the Centers for Disease and Prevention, other states, or other entities acting on behalf of the state.
