FISCAL NOTE

HB 2240 - SB 2171

February 5, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a state agency to disclose to another state agency the identity of any individual or organization the agency is investigating or pursuing a civil, administrative, or criminal matter against. Requires a state agency to disclose investigative records to another state agency upon written request. Requires records disclosed remain confidential and not discoverable by a party in the civil, administrative, or criminal litigation, unless the record is a basis of charges or allegations in the requesting agency's litigation.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Authorizing a state agency to disclose to another the identity of any individual or organization the agency is investigating or pursuing a civil, administrative, or criminal matter against will not result in a significant increase in state expenditures.
- Requiring such disclosed records be treated as confidential except in certain circumstances will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state government.
