FISCAL NOTE

HB 2242 - SB 2173

February 13, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Decreases, from \$5,000 to \$3,500, the prize threshold for which the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation (TELC) must report monthly to the Department of Human Services (DHS) of any individuals who have won such an amount or more.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Decreasing the threshold for when an individual is reported to DHS will not impact lottery sales or net lottery proceeds. Any impact on assistance programs administered by DHS will be not significant.
- Any increase in hours worked due to the proposed threshold decrease on an already required report is estimated to be absorbable within existing TELC staff and resources.
