**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Removes Nathan Bedford Forrest Day as a day of special observance.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

Assumptions:

- Nathan Bedford Forrest Day is currently observed on July 13.
- Special observance days are largely ceremonial and do not constitute legal holidays.
- Removing this day from the current list of special observance days will have no significant impact to state or local government.
