**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2286 - SB 2406**

February 18, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires an entity that employs or contracts with drivers who use the driver's person vehicle for delivery of the entity's goods or services, and that does not provide automobile insurance coverage to those drivers, to inform the drivers at the time of hire that the driver's automobile insurance may not cover commercial uses and that the drivers should check with their insurance providers as to whether commercial uses of the driver's personal vehicle are covered.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

Assumption:

- Requiring an entity to inform a hired delivery driver that the driver's automobile insurance may not cover commercial uses will have no significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
