SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation's (TBI) endangered child and young adult program, distinct from America's Missing Broadcast Emergency Response Alert system, to include endangered persons under 21 years of age to notify local media.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The TBI has a variety of systems related to vulnerable people that go missing, including the Blue Alert System and Care Alert program.
- Any increase in workload as a result of notifying local media about a missing person who is under 21 years of age and who meets the criteria of being endangered, as established or determined by TBI, can be accomplished with existing resources and personnel.
