FISCAL NOTE

HB 2377 - SB 2823

March 5, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Revises the SBE's authority to reprimand, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew an educator's license to apply to specific felony convictions and other criminal offenses. Requires SBE to provide copies of a report submitted by school officials related to an employee who has been suspended or dismissed, or who has resigned, following allegations, that if substantiated, would warrant consideration for license suspension or revocation, within 10 days to the identified licensed educator.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- SBE will be able to comply with the proposed legislation within existing resources.
