FISCAL NOTE

HB 2378 - SB 2287

February 24, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Continues permanent rules filed with the Secretary of State (SOS) after January 1, 2019. Establishes that specific rules under the Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (DIDD) and the Board for Professional Counselors, Marital and Family Therapists, and Clinical Pastoral Therapists (Board) previously filed with the SOS will expire on the effective date of this legislation.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The continuation of permanent rules beyond the current expiration date of June 30, 2020, will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
- The specific rules expiring for both the DIDD and the Board will have no significant fiscal impact to either entity.
