HB 2396 - SB 2293

February 8, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits a public agency from requiring a 501(c) organization to provide personal information or requiring a current or prospective contractor with the public agency to provide a list of 501(c) organizations to which it has provided financial or nonfinancial support. Prohibits a public agency from disclosing 501(c) organization's personal information without written consent. Specifies certain circumstances that personal information may be disclosed, including warrants and requests for discovery in litigation. Authorizes civil action for violations of confidentiality.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation would make 501(c) personal information, including any list, record, register, registry, roll, roster, or other compilation of data of any kind that directly or indirectly identifies a person as a member, supporter, or volunteer of, or donor of financial or nonfinancial support confidential except in specific instances.
- This does not include information reportable to the Secretary of State or campaign finance disclosures.
- Managing 501(c) records is not anticipated to increase expenditures for public agencies.
- There will not be enough civil action dispositions to have a significant fiscal impact on state or local government.
