SUMMARY OF BILL: Decreases, from 90 to 60, the number of days from receipt of a valid judgement of conviction that the Department of Correction has to notify the victim witness coordinator in the county of such conviction of a scheduled parole hearing date.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any fiscal impact to the Department of Correction resulting from decreasing the notification period for parole hearings is estimated to be not significant.
