HB 2406 - SB 2783

February 26, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a person aggrieved by final decision of the state's university boards and the board of trustees of the University of Tennessee (UT) system to file a petition for a contested case hearing to object to such decisions.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Passage of the proposed legislation will have no effect on policies or procedures of the state's university boards or the UT board of trustees; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Based on information provided by the Administrative Office of the Courts, any increase in the number of hearing petitions filed is estimated to be not significant.
