SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a breastfeeding mother to be excused from serving as a juror if certain criteria are met.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation requires that a person asking to be excused on the basis of being a breastfeeding mother provide the court with a supporting medical statement from a licensed physician and take all actions necessary to have obtained a ruling on the request by no later than the day on which the person is scheduled to appear for jury duty.
- Any impact to the court system resulting from authorizing breastfeeding mothers meeting the outlined criteria to be excused from jury duty is estimated to be not significant.
