FISCAL NOTE

HB 2496 - SB 2719

February 21, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the state university boards and advisory boards for the University of Tennessee (UT) system to meet electronically without a physical quorum, and without filing a determination of necessity, provided that the advisory boards for UT have had a physical quorum present at the location of a meeting at least one time in the previous 12 months. Extends, from April 15 to May 31, the date by which the faculty member and the student member must be appointed to a UT institution advisory board.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Authorizing the state university boards and the advisory boards for the UT system to meet electronically without a physical quorum and without filing a determination of necessity will not have a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
- Extending the date by which the faculty member and the student member must be appointed to a UT advisory board will have no effect on the operations of the boards; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
