FISCAL NOTE

HB 2572 - SB 2637

February 6, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Clarifies that four-year institutions of higher education that were formerly governed by the Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR), and are now governed by state university boards, do not offer remedial or developmental courses.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Public Chapter 869 of the Public Acts of 2016 restructured TBR and created state university boards of trustees.
- The proposed legislation updates language in order to accurately address the current governing structure of the state's public institutions of higher education; therefore, any fiscal impact to state government is estimated to be not significant.
