SUMMARY OF BILL: Recognizes the following cultural groups as Tennessee's first peoples: Algonquin, Shawnee, Lenape, Chickamaugan, Iroquoian, including the Cherokee, Muskogean, including the Alabama, Coosa, Chickasaw, Natchez, Koasati, Tuskegee, Taliwa, Siaouan, including the Quapaw and Mosepelia, and the Yuchean, including the Taougalé, Tongeria, and Tamahita.
