HB 2600 - SB 2818

SUMMARY OF BILL: Directs the Tennessee Film, Entertainment, and Music Commission to perform a study regarding film production incentives in Tennessee and contiguous states and report the findings to the Chief Clerks and the Chairs of the Finance, Ways, and Means Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives. The report must be provided by February 1, 2021.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumption:

- It is estimated that the Tennessee Film, Entertainment, and Music Commission can perform and report this study by February 1, 2021 utilizing existing staff and resources. Any impact on state expenditures will be not significant.
