**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2604 – SB 2819**

February 6, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation (Corporation) and its Board of Directors to comply with the Tennessee Minority-Owned, Woman-Owned, Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned, Business Owned by Persons with Disabilities, and Small Business Procurement and Contracting Act (Act) when contracting with a third party to enforce and supervise compliance with applicable laws and rules.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The Corporation and its Board of Directors have been committed to the Equal Business Opportunity (EBO) Program since inception, which helps maximize participation of minority-owned businesses across the state.
- It is assumed that any difference between the Act and EBO Program are few.
- This legislation is estimated to have no significant impact on state or local government.
