**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2611 - SB 2722**

April 14, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases, from 10 years to 12 years, the amount of full-time work experience in wildlife or fisheries management, wildlife biology, or other related work experience in this state or another state which may be credited as equivalent to a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in wildlife or fisheries management, wildlife biology, or other related acceptable field for purposes of qualifying for the position of wildlife officer with the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA).

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Changes will apply beginning January 1, 2021.
- Increasing the number of required years of experience in certain wildlife disciplines necessary to qualify as a TWRA wildlife officer by two years will have no significant impact on state government.
