FISCAL NOTE

HB 2631 - SB 2601

February 10, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies any person obtaining a hemp producer license must not have been convicted of a felony drug offense committed in another state within the previous ten years.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 43-27-102(b)(4), a person is currently prohibited from obtaining a hemp producer license if such person has been convicted of a state or federal felony drug offense within the past ten years.
- This legislation just specifies that the aforementioned statute applies to any felony drug offense committed within the previous ten years, including those committed in another state; therefore, this legislation is estimated to have no significant impact on state government.
