**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2677 - SB 2718**

February 9, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Exempts a person age 75 years or older with a medical condition from jury duty upon written request and documentation from a physician. Requires a jury coordinator to excuse a person upon receiving the request in writing, which must be accompanied by an affidavit giving the person's name, age, reason, or basis for making the request, and such other information as the jury coordinator may require. Requires the jury coordinator of each county to make available affidavit forms for this purpose.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Any additional workload for the courts, as a result of this legislation, can be accommodated within existing resources and personnel.
- Exempting a person age 75 years or older with a medical condition from jury duty upon written request and documentation from a physician will not result in a significant increase to state or local expenditures.
