FISCAL NOTE

HB 2766 - SB 2652

March 12, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Defines teacher, as an individual who holds a license to teach issued by the State Board of Education (SBE) and who spends 50 percent or more of the individual's time on the job instructing, for the purpose of a state salary increase for public school teachers proposed in the state budget document or included in the general appropriations bill. Requires the state budget document and the general appropriations bill to account for the salary increase for teachers separate from the salary increase for other licensed or certified personnel or staff if a state salary increase is proposed in the state budget document or included in the general appropriations bill for teachers and other licensed or certified personnel or staff.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation requires salary increases for licensed teachers to be accounted for separately from licensed or certified personnel in the budget document or general appropriations bill.
- Any differentiation between staff for the purposes of salary increases or budgeting will not affect the amount of funds appropriated; thus any impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
