HB 2772 - SB 2630

SUMMARY OF BILL: Clarifies the requirements for a clerk of court to assess a fee for electronic filing, including authorization by local rule and compliance with technological standards promulgated by the Supreme Court.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-21-401(o)(1), in any court where electronic filing, signing, or verification of papers has been authorized by local court rule, and is in accordance with Rule 5B of the Tennessee Rules of Civil Procedure, clerks may assess a transaction fee for each filing submitted by a party to the case.
- To assert the permissive electronic filings must be in compliance with technological standards established by the Supreme Court will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
