SUMMARY OF BILL: Clarifies that training provided to low-income entrepreneurs participating in the micro-lending program available to certain Temporary Assistance for Needy Families recipients includes entrepreneurial training.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 71-3-907, the micro-lending program is dependent on the availability of appropriate federal waivers, for which the Department of Human Services (DHS) applies.
- Clarifying the type of training included for participants of the micro-lending program will not significantly impact the policies or procedures of the DHS; therefore, any fiscal impact to state government is estimated to be not significant.
