HB 2810 - SB 2626

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends, from February 1 to March 1, the deadline for the Comptroller of the Treasury (COT) to submit an annual written report to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Speaker of the Senate.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-82-401, the COT is required to submit a report detailing the average annual water loss for utility districts.
- Extending the deadline for submission of such annual report will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Extending the deadline for submission of a currently required report will not result in any significant impact to jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
