**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Adds tickets and coupons to the list of legal instruments that a nonprofit organization is authorized to award as a non-cash prize at charitable gaming events.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 3-17-110(b), a nonprofit organization hosting a charitable gaming event is authorized to award non-cash prizes as legal instruments including, but not limited to, deeds, titles, and gift certificates.
- Nonprofit organizations are not currently prohibited from awarding tickets or coupons at charitable gaming events.
- No significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
