FISCAL NOTE

HB 2884 - SB 2727

February 13, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends civil immunity to a charitable organization, or employee, volunteer, or independent contractor of a charitable organization that discloses, in good faith, to an individual's subsequent or prospective employer allegations of sexual abuse or misconduct. Specifies that this immunity does not apply if a charitable organization or an employee, volunteer, or independent contractor of a charitable organization had a legal duty to report an act of child abuse, neglect, or sexual abuse and failed to make the mandatory report or made a disclosure in bad faith or with malicious purpose.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Any impact resulting from this legislation will be borne by private parties to civil actions.
- This legislation will not significantly impact courts' caseloads. Any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
