SUMMARY OF BILL: Designates the month of April 2019 as “Child Abuse Prevention Month” in Tennessee in an effort to raise awareness of child abuse and to encourage communities throughout our state to create partnerships among social service agencies, schools, religious organizations, law enforcement agencies, and the business community and to become involved in supporting parents in raising their children in a safe, nurturing environment.
