SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Agriculture (DOA) to annually report to the Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee of the House of Representatives and to the Energy, Agriculture, and Natural Resources Committee of the Senate the number of applied for and issued licenses to grow or process industrial hemp during the preceding calendar year, and the number of acres located in Tennessee that were under cultivation for industrial hemp in the preceding calendar year.
