SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits a partial owner of a hooved mammal from using the milk of that hooved mammal for their own personal consumption or use.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Any impact on the license, registration and fee revenue collected by the Department of Agriculture will be not significant. Further, enforcement and inspection activities of the Department will not be significantly impacted.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 53-3-115, any violation of the Dairy Law of the State of Tennessee, either doing acts prohibited by the Law or failing to do the acts required by the Law, is a Class C misdemeanor offense.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.

Assumption:

- Any impact to jobs or commerce as a result of this legislation is estimated to be not significant.
