**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 41 – HB 178**

March 14, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Extends, from 10 to 30 days, the time period in which an owner of a utility facility that occupies or may occupy the rights-of-way of a highway is required to respond to the second notice from the Department of Transportation (TDOT). Extends, from 10 to 30 days, the time period in which such owner may file a reservation of rights notice with TDOT after the issuance of a notice to proceed.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

Assumption:

- Extending the two deadlines by 20 days will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
