FISCAL NOTE

SB 93 – HB 1226

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds two members of the General Assembly to the Advisory Committee on Open Government.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – \$2,100

Assumptions:

- The Speakers of the Senate and the House of Representatives will each appoint one member of the General Assembly to serve on the Committee.
- The Committee will meet three times per year outside of the regular legislative session.
- Tennessee Code Annotated § 3-1-106(a) states that each member of the General Assembly shall be paid for the member's expenses in attending legislative committee meetings concerning state business and duties of a legislator.
- Members of the General Assembly will be paid a rate of \$240 per day for meals and lodging and an average of \$110 for mileage reimbursement per roundtrip.
- Adding two members of the General Assembly to the Committee will result in a recurring increase in state expenditures estimated to be \$2,100 [(\$240 meals and lodging reimbursement x 2 members) + (\$110 mileage reimbursement x 2 members) x 3 meetings].
