SB 116

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends the termination date of the Underground Utility Damage Enforcement Board (UUDEB) to June 30, 2021. Under the *Tennessee Governmental Entity Review Law*, the Board is scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2019. Requires the Comptroller of the Treasury (COT) to conduct a study on the allocation of employees from the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (TPUC) to the UUDEB.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This bill continues an existing entity at its current funding level.
- According to TPUC, the UUDEB's expenditures were \$289,984 in FY16-17 and \$301,143 in FY17-18.
- According to the COT, the required study can be conducted utilizing existing staff and resources and therefore will not result in any significant fiscal impact to the state.
