FISCAL NOTE

SB 182 – HB 248

February 12, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires each local board of education to adopt policies allowing the parent of a student to view photos or video footage collected from a camera installed on a school bus, if the parent's student reports that physical harm, harassment, intimidation, or bullying has occurred while being transported on the school bus. Requires the policies comply with federal and state privacy laws and requires that photos or footage be viewed under the supervision of the director of schools, the school principal, or other school official. Authorizes a local board of education to include in the policy, a process or timeframe for a student's parent to request and view such photos or video footage.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Local education agencies (LEAs) will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources without any significant additional expenditure.
- Local boards of education and LEAs will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
