SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends, from 30 to 45 days, the time period by which a registrant of any board under the Division of Health Related Boards (HRBs) must notify the Division of a change in the registrant's official address.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Extending the time period for registrants to notify the Division of HRBs of a change of address will have no fiscal impact upon the Division.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all HRBs are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The HRBs had an annual surplus of \$3,609,723 in FY16-17, an annual surplus of \$3,621,024 in FY17-18, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$34,646,763 on June 30, 2018.
