SB 343 – HB 534

February 11, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Decreases, from 18 to 12 months, the time period in which a health insurance entity can recoup reimbursements to a provider, except in cases of fraud.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumption:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Commerce and Insurance and the Department of Health, the proposed legislation will not impact any programs or policies of the departments; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.

**IMPACT TO COMMERCE:**

**Other Commerce Impact – Due to multiple unknown factors, the exact impact to commerce and jobs cannot be quantified with reasonable certainty.**

Assumption:

- It is unknown how many health insurance entities, healthcare providers, and claims would be affected by the proposed legislation; therefore, an exact impact to commerce cannot be determined with reasonable certainty.
