SB 528 – HB 1125

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes obsolete section of statute, Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-11-267, that requires the Department of Health and the Infections Taskforce to submit a progress report to the General Assembly each year for three years, beginning in 2008, on strategies and recommendations for the prevention and control of antibiotic resistant infections including methicillin resistant staphylococcus aureus.
