SB 580 - HB 701

March 15, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends, from 15 to 20 days, the time period following the end of a month that certain courts are required to submit caseload data to the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 16-1-117(a)(4), all courts, other than juvenile courts, general sessions courts, and municipal courts with general sessions jurisdiction are required to report case data to the AOC by the fifteenth day after the end of the previous month.
- Based on information provided by the AOC, any impact resulting from extending the reporting deadline by five days is estimated to be not significant.
