SB 581 - HB 1157

February 27, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from 7 to 10 days, the time period prior to certain meetings for which a local government is required to publish notice of the meeting.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation would require notice of meetings on certain contracts, leases, or lease-purchase agreements concerning a local education agency to be published at least 10 days prior to the meeting. Notice of such meetings is currently being published at least seven days prior to the meeting, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-51-904.
- Requiring local governments to provide notice of a meeting three days earlier will not result in any significant fiscal impact to local government.
