SB 595 - HB 732

SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the authority to authorize, regulate, and control commercial use of pedal carriages and rickshaws for any municipality or metropolitan government in the state.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-26-102, by ordinance of its legislative body, any home rule municipality or metropolitan government may authorize, regulate and control the commercial use of pedal carriages and rickshaws as modes of transportation-for-hire within entertainment, dining, scenic and/or historic areas of the center city.
- Expanding the authority to authorize, regulate, and control commercial use of pedal carriages and rickshaws to any municipality or metropolitan government in the state will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
