FISCAL NOTE

SB 638

February 6, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that a digital copy, photograph, or image of a driver license that is not downloaded through the electronic driver license system on a cellular telephone or other portable electronic device is not a valid electronic driver license.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-50-306, a person who participates in the system may, in lieu of a physical driver license, present or submit evidence of possession of a valid driver license in an electronic format, which shall be accepted as such evidence for identification and other purposes, including upon the request of a law enforcement officer or a seller of alcoholic beverages.
- The Department of Safety (DOS) shall not charge a fee to participate in the electronic driver license system.
- It is reasonably assumed that the provisions of this legislation will have no impact on the number of driver license applications; therefore, it will have no significant fiscal impact on the Department's revenue from fees.
- Specifying that an electronic driver license must be downloaded through DOS's electronic driver license system to be considered valid will not result in any significant impact to DOS.
