SB 693 - HB 1145

SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes, from December 31 to December 1, the date by which the Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) must issue an annual report regarding the number of employers that failed, during the preceding fiscal year, to provide workers' compensation coverage or qualify as a self-insured employer.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Changing the date by which the specified report must be submitted will not result in a significant fiscal impact on the BWC or its operations. Therefore, any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
