SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes, from 30 days to 30 business days, the time period in which ambulance providers are required to submit quarterly transport count data for all transports to the Office of Emergency Services.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Health and the Division of TennCare; the proposed legislation will not impact any current programs or policies; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The proposed legislation will not increase the number of ambulance service providers. It changes the time period in which ambulance providers must submit certain data; therefore, any impact to commerce and jobs in Tennessee is estimated to be not significant.
