FISCAL NOTE

SB 772 - HB 1034

March 14, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development (DLWD), in collaboration with the Commissioner of the Department of Correction (DOC), to study the use of a shared data system to track individuals released from a correctional facility to employment, including the system's usefulness in monitoring the impact of postsecondary education programs used in correctional facilities. Requires both Commissioners to submit a report of their findings and any recommendations to the State and Local Government Committee of the Senate and House of Representatives no later than January 31, 2020.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the DOC, requiring a report of the findings within the use of the shared data systems, can be absorbed within the department's existing staff and resources without a significant impact on state expenditures.
- Requiring the Commissioner of DLWD to submit a report of the findings within the use of the shared data systems, can be absorbed within the Department's existing staff and resources without a significant impact on state expenditures.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

Assumption:

- Requiring the Commissioners to submit a report will not have any significant impact on commerce or jobs in Tennessee.
