SB 882 – HB 1111

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes members of the state executive committee for the minority party in existence during the 111th General Assembly to be appointed by rules of the party.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-13-103(a), members of the state executive committee for each statewide political party are elected at the regular August primary election.
- Passage of this legislation would authorize the minority party in existence during the 111th General Assembly to appoint members of the state executive committee by rules of the party.
- Authorizing the minority party to appoint members by rules of the party will not result in any significant decrease in state or local expenditures because the majority party will still have an election during the regular August primary election.
