FISCAL NOTE

SB 1022 – HB 1367

February 8, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes electronic submission of the annual joint report on the current status of emergency medical services for children and the continuing efforts to improve such services that the Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities (HCF) and the Emergency Medical Services Board (EMS) are required to jointly submit to the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate and the Health Committee of the House of Representatives.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Authorizing the Board of HCF and the EMS Board to submit the joint annual report electronically will have no significant impact on the procedures or processes of either Board.
- The Board of HCF and the EMS Board are each required to collect fees in amounts sufficient to pay the costs of operating the Boards. All fees collected by each Board is deposited by the Department of Health (DOH) with the State Treasurer to the credit of the General Fund and shall be expended by the Department and included in the appropriation made for each Board in the *General Appropriations Act*.
- Any change in expenditures of the Boards is estimated to be not significant.
- The Board of HCF had a deficit of \$161,129 in FY16-17 and a deficit of \$562,731 in FY17-18.
- The EMS Board had a deficit of \$113,546 in FY16-17 and a deficit of \$149,731 in FY17-18.
