SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds retired correctional counselors previously employed by the Department of Correction (TDOC) to those authorized to become certified to carry firearms in the same manner as active duty law enforcement at all times and in all places with certain exceptions.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 38-8-116(c)(1), a retired law enforcement officer or a retired correctional officer or inmate relations coordinator previously employed by TDOC may become certified to carry a firearm within this state that has been shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce in the same manner and to the same extent as authorized for an active law enforcement officer.
- Authorizing retired correctional counselors previously employed by TDOC to become certified to carry firearms will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
- Any impact to revenue or expenditures of the Handgun Permit Division of the Department of Safety is estimated to be not significant.
