FISCAL NOTE

SB 1589 - HB 1603

January 21, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Safety (DOS) to report, on or before February 1, 2020, to the Transportation Committees of House and the Transportation and Safety Committee of the Senate the number of commercial driver license holders who previously held military commercial driver licenses and whether they experienced any barriers in applying.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Assuming this legislation passes prior to February 1, 2020 report deadline, DOS's "A-list" driver license program is currently capable of executing a report containing the necessary information per this legislation.
- Preparation of report could be handled within existing personnel and resources; therefore, there will not be a significant fiscal impact to state expenditures.
